- \*Was the work introduced by Roberto Daolio and Alberto Garulli? (If so, how?)

  Bologita?
- \*Is it correct that Nada Cingolani presented a technical drawing of her family tree, daring back to the 15th century? She related this to a box from which she set loose a carrier pigeon on the day of the opening?
- \*Did Diego Perrone make a video of two white geese?
- \*Did Alexandra Tesi contribute two photographs mounted on alumnum panels? These were in the gallery's central room on the floor, resting against the wall, and they depicted two armchairs? Did they form one piece, entitled Attesa? What is the date of this work?
- "In a small recess of the gallery did Tesi also place a projector? Was this a slide projector? Was this piece called Beite? Were there projected images of a small, old hotel in Paris? Did the images include parts of rooms, partial views of stairways, door-handles, a mirror, and a bathroom? What is the date of this work?

\*We plan to reproduce Attesa. How exactly should we list the materials for this work? What are the dimensions for the piece?
