Fragmented Show opens Tuesday, October 10th. Fragmented Show is the exhibition of works by the students of the Advanced Course in Visual Arts of the Antonio Ratti Foundation, directed by Annie Ratti. The exhibition, curated by Anna Daneri, Roberto Pinto and Cesare Pietroiusti, is in collaboration with Artegiovane Milano, Careof, neon>fdv and Viafarini, and under the patronage of the Municipality of Milan.

During the opening of the exhibition at the Fabbrica del Vapore – the exhibition space of the Department of Youth of the Municipality of Milan - the three winners of the *EPSON FAR award for artistic research* will be announced at 8.00 p.m. The prize has been founded this year thanks to the contribution of Epson Italia that has chosen to support young artists by awarding the most interesting works of visual experimentation.

The School of Art - Faculty of Built Environment Art & Design, Curtin University of Technology, Western Australia, the Skuč Gallery Ljubljana (Slovenia), the Museum Boijmans Van Beuningen, Rotterdam (Holland), The Office for Contemporary Art Norway (OCA), the Svenska Konstskolans Vänner (SKV) Nykarleby (Finland) and The Arts Council of Ireland have offered grants to the young artists of their countries.

Following the reflections developed this summer during Marjetica Potrč's artistic and theoretical workshop entitled *Fragmented City*, the students now present their projects in the exhibition spaces of Fabbrica del Vapore, Careof, neon>fdv and Viafarini.

The four sites emphasize from a logistic perspective the concept of urban fragmentation and decentralization, one of the main issues of this year's course.



The three students winners of the EPSON FAR award for artistic research will be selected by a jury composed by an international curator/art critic and two other members representing the Antonio Ratti Foundation and Epson. The winners will receive Epson high technology devices.

Fragmented Show is accompanied by a publication, realized by Produzioni Nero, that illustrates the student's work and their biographies. The 2006 catalogue on the Visiting Professor Marjetica Potrč, published by Actar, will also be presented on this occasion.
